



Midwest Sky Embroidered Fireworks

Among the shooting stars, a very large and bright fireball, fireball, revealed the Midwest sky.

On the 3rd afternoon, fireworks shootings were reported in Illinois, Indiana, Iowa, Kentucky, Minnesota, Missouri, Ohio and Wisconsin.

The American Meteor Society (AMS) says it has received more than 100 fire stellar reports. AMS explained, "The fire stellar trail is so large and so bright that the actual stellar trajectory would have been seen across midwest, passing through northern Indiana."

It is not known whether the shooting star entered the atmosphere low enough to drop debris.

AMS said, "Thousands of shooting stars and sparking stars enter the Earth's atmosphere each day, but most of them pass undetected."
