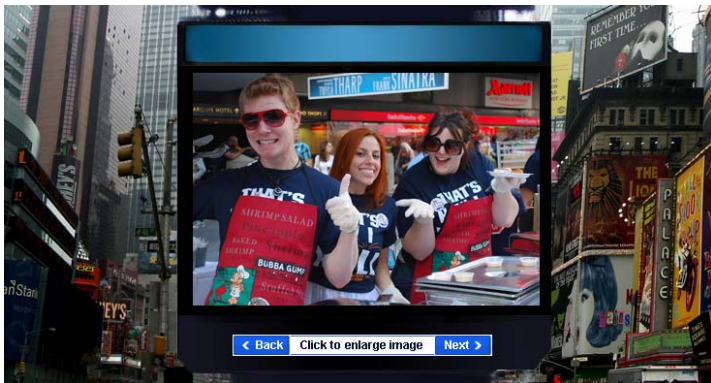


The Taste of Times Square Featured On EarthCam June 8, 2010
