

FPL launches manatee webcam



Wanna watch a bunch of manatees trying to stay warm? Florida Power & Light has set up a webcam of the massive sea creatures hovering around the warm waters in the Lake Worth Lagoon, near the utility's Riveria Beach power plant.

The Manatee Cam -- at FPL.com/manatees -- went up Friday morning, focusing on a spot where they traditionally congregate where temperatures drop.

The plant is currently shut down for a refurbishing, but FPL has set up a temporary heating system to help the manatees during the cooler months.

A press release from the utility said has sponsored aerial manatee surveys during the winter months and found about 1,200 gather near FPL facilities.
