

Air and Wind, the hawks of Wisdom, four eggs and millions of fans on webcam

For the sixth consecutive year, Air and Wind, the two peregrine falcons that nest on the cornice of the Faculty of Economics of Wisdom, have laid the first eggs of the season. The two birds of prey have become stars of the web does not therefore have disappointed their fans who follow their adventures in real time via webcam installed in front of the nest box is located at www.birdcam.it.

The project Birdcam was born from the collaboration of Terna, which has been available to the electricity pylons for the species in search of a nest, Wisdom and Ornithologica, an Italian association of Wildlife Research. The portal

Compared to last year, the two hawks have slightly delayed the first deposition, which ever took place, as in previous years, in the first week of March. Were initially laid three eggs, all red, at intervals of two days, and just today came in fourth, and perhaps last season. Everything, as always, live streaming.



After an incubation of about 33-35 days the eggs hatch and the chicks will remain in the nest for about 40 days before being able to fly. So far, twelve young peregrines have involati the nest of Wisdom from 2005 to today, and stages of their development have been followed online by thousands of fans around the world, intrigued by the return to Rome after an absence of this species around thirty.
