

Weather: Fog, then sun ... but the rain's coming back February 9, 2010

Thick fog blankets much of Seattle this morning, as this view of downtown from the Space Needle Webcam shows. (From our vantage point down the hill at the P-I Building, the top of the Needle vanishes into the clouds well below the restaurant level.)

The fog should burn off by 10 a.m., according to the National Weather Service. Forecast for the rest of the day: sunny, with highs around 51.

Enjoy it while it lasts: rain appears likely the rest of the week.
