

Webcams capture two years of World Trade Center reconstruction

An array of webcams placed around the Ground Zero site show the new One World Trade Center rising into the sky to become the new tallest building in New York.

The time-lapse video footage of the new One World Trade Center building rising into the sky was captured by multiple webcams placed around the site. Showing the construction process between February 2010 and September 2012, the film is designed to commemorate the 11th anniversary of the September 11 attacks. EarthCam, the company behind the project, operates networks of webcams at locations around the globe, including several in New York.
