

## Cherry Blossom cam offers stunning view of the trees around the Tidal Basin

WASHINGTON (WJLA) - With just days left to go until peak bloom time for the cherry blossoms, one D.C. agency is offering a way for fans of the popular blossoms to see them without leaving the house.

The National Park Service (NPS) and EarthCam have partnered together to offer a livestream of the Tidal Basin in D.C. Viewers will be able to watch Yoshino Cherry trees, as well as paddleboaters around the basin.

NPS predicts peak bloom time for the cherry blossom trees starts Saturday and runs through April 14. The National Cherry Blossom Festival, which opened on March 20, ends on Sunday.
