

## Watch Wrigley Field get a speedy makeover, thanks to this time-lapse video

Wrigley Field appears to get a speedy makeover in a time-lapse video released Monday by [EarthCam](#).

Pepper Construction hired the New Jersey-based company to document the latest phase of Wrigley's \$750 million renovation. The 1-minute-and-31-second video shows the progress construction crews made between October and last week's Cubs home opener remodeling the club and field box sections and building new premium clubs along the first- and third-base lines.

One of EarthCam's high-definition robotic cameras is perched above the bleachers and captures the seasons changing as snow and heavy equipment blanket the outfield.

A fourth camera captured footage of crews building the interior of the American Airlines 1914 Club behind home plate, but that video will be released later.

EarthCam has been documenting other major building and renovation projects in Chicago, including Vista Tower, the 98-story \$900 million riverfront condominium and hotel, as well as One Bennett Park, One Grant Park, the Old Post Office and Union Station.
