



## Hwy 406 bridge over Glendale coming down

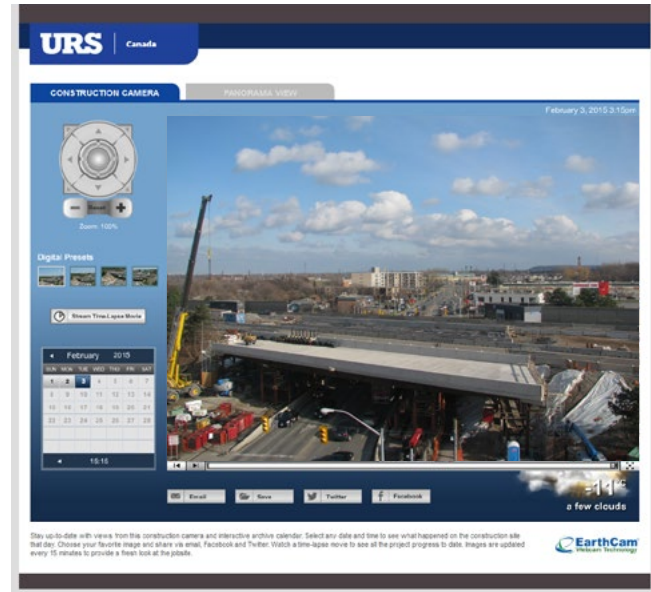

The southbound Hwy. 406 bridge over Glendale Ave. in St. Catharines will be removed overnight Saturday and a new span will be slid into place.

The rapid bridge replacement technique called jack-and-slide allows the Ministry of Transportation to replace the bridge in hours instead of months.

The jack-and-slide starts at 7 p.m. Saturday and continues until Sunday at 10 a.m. Residents can watch a live feed at [www.earthcam.net/projects/urs/canada](http://www.earthcam.net/projects/urs/canada) where a photo of the worksite will be displayed every three minutes.

The bridge and the section of Glendale Ave. under it will be closed during the jack-and-slide. Last weekend, the northbound span was replaced.
