

Time-Lapse of the Week: Golden 1 Center, One of the Greenest Arenas

Construction on the new home of the Sacramento Kings wrapped at the beginning of October after kicking off a little more than two years ago, in August 2014. The more than \$550 million arena is LEED Platinum-certified; workers recycled almost all the building materials from the demolished Downtown Plaza mall that once occupied the site, more than a third of the new venue's materials came from recycled sources, and Solar Power Inc. installed PV panels on its roof that will power it during the day. At times, Turner Construction had as many as 500 workers on site to complete the 675,000-square-foot project in time for the 2017-2018 NBA season.
