

## Time lapse shows 11-year construction of One World Trade Center

NEW YORK, May 29 (UPI) -- The opening of the One World Observatory atop New York's One World Trade Center is being celebrated with a [time-lapse video of the tower's 11-year construction](#).

The video, created and shared on YouTube by webcam services company [EarthCam](#), was created from high definition images starting with the onset of One World Trade Center's construction in October 2004 to Memorial Day 2015.

The video celebrates Friday's opening of One World Observatory 1,250 feet up on the 1,776-foot-tall skyscraper.

Visitors to the observatory, which offers a 360-degree view, are treated to a time-lapse video on their elevator ride showing the evolution of the New York skyline from the 1500s to the present day.
