

Watch the Louvre Abu Dhabi be built in just three minutes

The new Jean Nouvel-designed Louvre Abu Dhabi took eight years to construct, but thanks to [EarthCam](#), we can watch it be built in just three short minutes.

The webcam provider created a time-lapse video which shows the site be transformed from an empty, barren island into a 23-gallery museum covered by a 180-metre wide dome that has been dubbed an architectural masterpiece. The video contains an edit of 70,000 hours of footage taken from 50 different angles across the site.
