

## Watch time-lapse of Flight 93 National Memorial center construction

The Flight 93 National Memorial opens a new visitor center complex Sept. 10, and you can now watch a video of how construction unfolded.

EarthCam partnered with the National Park Service, National Park Foundation and Friends of Flight 93 to make the video, which shows more than 1,800 days of footage in two minutes, according to a news release.

The memorial and visitor center honor the victims of the Flight 93 plane crash on Sept. 11, 2001.
