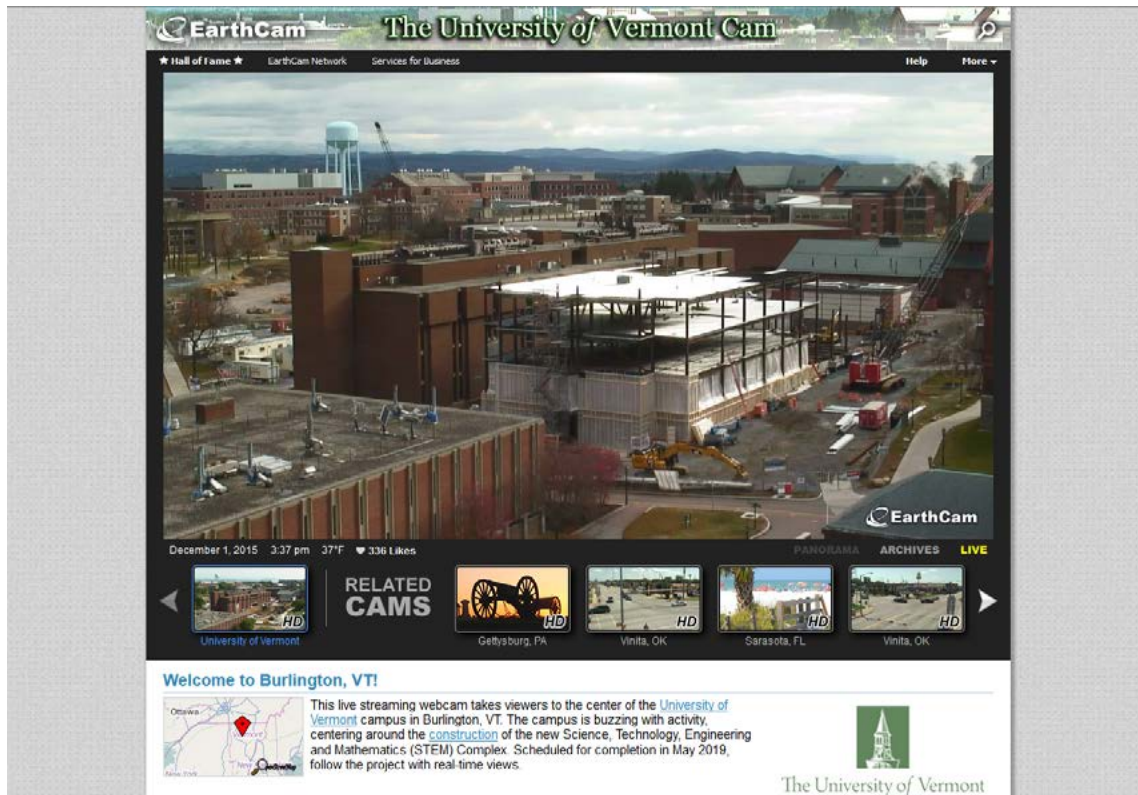


Go back to school with EarthCam's new live webcam at University of Vermont
